Susie and David Bach team up for an hour long culinary radio show.

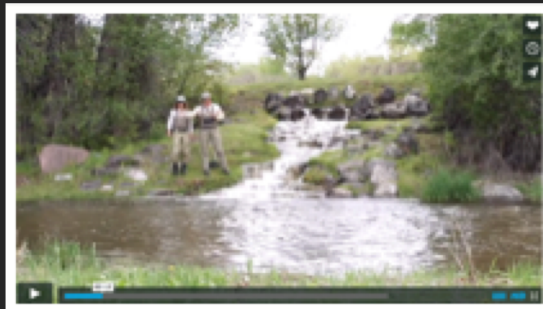
In each segment, Susie brings a different member of the local culinary community - a farmer, chef, brewer - to highlight their products and unique touch to the valley.

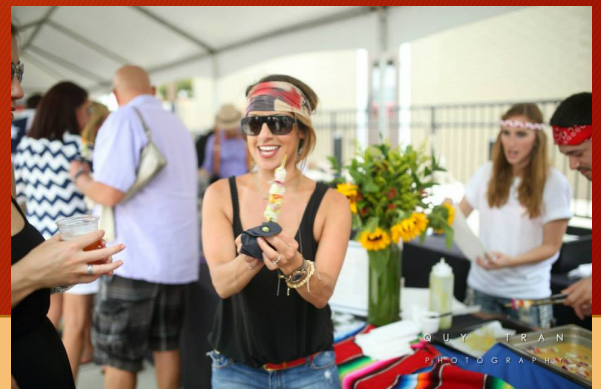
